



Public Transportation in Georgetown

St. John's Preschool is located on the second floor of St. John's Episcopal Church, between Wisconsin Avenue and 33rd St on O St at the corner of O and Potomac Streets. Caution: one-way streets prevail in our historic neighborhood.

There are several methods of public transportation that provide access to Georgetown.

Metro:

While there is no direct Metro train service to Georgetown, you can easily walk here from either the Foggy Bottom stop or the Rosslyn stop (both on the Orange/Blue line) or the Dupont Circle stop on the Red line. Expect about a mile walk from each stop (maybe a bit more from Foggy Bottom). There is bus service from all stations to Georgetown on Metrobus or the DC circulator. DC Circulator:

The red DC Circulator is an excellent bus service that will bring you within a block of our school. Buses run every 10 minutes from most areas in the city. Routes run to Georgetown from Dupont Circle, Rosslyn, and Union Station. The Circulator stops nearest our school are at the corner of Wisconsin and Dumbarton Streets NW or M and 33rd Streets. Fare is \$1.00 and routes and information can be found at www.dccirculator.com.

Metrobus:
